News Letter from Davis Rubbish Removal and Recycling

Effective October 1, 2018

This letter contains all of the information you need to know about
Recycling and Trash Removal

RUBBISH REMOVAL:

1. Rubbish must be out at curbside no later than 8 am. No Exceptions
2. If you do not have it out on time we will not return to pick it up.
3. My service is subject to change due to weather conditions and holidays
4. Only up to 6 white kitchen bags will be allowed at curbside

This is due to customers using contractor bags and large green bags so heavy we can't pick them up.

RECYCLING:

1. No container of any kind will be picked up other than a 32 Gallon cheap, lightweight trash can with a cover. I suggest A trash can with wheels.
2. No open container or bin will be accepted due to winter coming, Rain, ice and snow are not recyclable.
3. Recycling in bags will no longer be accepted at curbside due To recycling facility demands.
4. No loose cardboard will be accepted at curbside, All cardboard boxes must be broken down and tied in a bundle no larger than 2x2 bundle
5. Small Cardboard can be put in a small cardboard Box.
6. No large pieces of cardboard can be put in your recycling barrel because It hampers dumping of the barrel.
7. Junk mail, magazines, newspaper and cereal boxes can be put in your Recycling barrel loose.
