

## CEMETERY HISTORY

IN 1987, the Madbury Board of Selectmen appointed a board of five people to serve on the Madbury Cemetery Committee. They were charged with the following:

- 1) Determine the need
- 2) Location and size
- 3) Cost to establish
- 4) Responsibilities

THE COMMITTEE took two years to research and study before making recommendations to the Board of Selectmen. As a result, the Madbury Memorial Park Capital Reserve Fund was established and contributions have been made to it annually. In 1991, the Town purchased 5.7 acres of land from Kenneth I. Tibbetts at the junction of Cherry Lane and Town Hall Road. The Committee continued to interview and benefit from the experiences, ideas, and knowledge of interview and benefit from the experiences, ideas, and knowledge of local cemetery personnel in order to create careful plans for developing the cemetery. In 1992, survey and design plans were developed. They were presented to the residents at the 1993 annual Town Meeting for approval. That summer, site preparations were completed, and the proposed plan was surveyed, excavated, and seeded. The Committee spent 1993 writing the Rules and Regulations, which were signed by the Board of Selectmen on November 1st, and which will regulate the operation of the Madbury Memorial Deviet on the Medbury Town Cometery. The 1994 coal has Memorial Park and the Madbury Town Cemetery. The 1994 goal has been to landscape the cemetery and complete the final plans, including the installation of granite fence posts, a flag pole, and some tree plantings. The Committee has attempted to have most of these plans completed in time for the Dedication Ceremony, but some activities will continue throughout the summer of 1994.

LOTS ARE offered for sale to any interested parties. In addition to grave plots, memorial markers on the granite fence posts are available.

THE COMMITTEE has future plans to create a Memorial Garden area adjacent to the cemetery and will continue its research to determine how the garden should be developed. Ideas and suggestions from the community are welcome.

THE COMMITTEE extends its appreciation to all the people involved in this cemetery project, especially to the citizens of Madbury for their encouragement and support.
