

**Nonpublic Session Minutes**  
**April 21, 2023**

The Selectmen reviewed a complaint from Aimee Rouillard-Routhier which was received through the Town's website contact form on 4/20/2023.

The complaint described a traffic interaction that occurred on 4/19/2023. There were some questions and clarifications needed on the story as presented. It was thought that one of the vehicles, as described in the complaint, could be Madbury Assistant Fire Chief Jim Davis' personnel vehicle. There was discussion on having the Police Chief investigate, and informing Jim Davis that there was a complaint.

Jim Davis was working in the building and grounds garage at the time and he was invited to the nonpublic meeting. He read the complaint and related his perspective of the interaction. He noted that there was a bike in the other lane when he was passed by the complainant. His emergency front grill mounted lights had been left on by accident from a previous call. His front license plate was missing due to a previous unrelated motor vehicle accident.

He also related that the complainant had "interfered" with a motor vehicle accident scene he had responded to on Rt. 155 on 4/20/2023. He had been in touch with Madbury Police Chief McGann on both interactions with the complainant.

Janet Wall, as the PD liaison, will speak with Chief McGann about the complaint and his investigation will be reported back to the Selectmen.

Eric Fiegenbaum, administrator, will respond to the complainant that the Selectmen were taking the matter under consideration and would take appropriate action.
