NONPUBLIC:

Motion to enter nonpublic session: made by Susan Ossoff and seconded by Tim Burt. Specific Statutory Reason cited: RSA 91-A:3, II (b), The hiring of any person as a public employee.

Roll Call vote: Susan Ossoff, yes; Tim Burt, yes; Mark Avery, yes. Motion passed. Entered nonpublic session at 7:057pm.

Other persons present during nonpublic session: Mathew Paugh, partial attendance. Susan Ossoff moved and Tim Burt seconded a motion to leave nonpublic session. Roll Call vote: Susan Ossoff, yes; Tim Burt, yes; Mark Avery, yes. Motion passed. Public session reconvened at 8:3028pm.

There was no motion to seal the nonpublic session.

NEW BUSINESS

- EF joined the public meeting after the nonpublic session, as he had been attending a Conservation Commission meeting. The Select Board noted that they had offered and Mat Paugh had accepted the eExpert rRoad aAgent position. EF will arrange a NH background check, begin bringing Mat Paugh on board, and notify Jay Moriarty to help with the transition. A discussion included wage rate, hours, mentoring, training, sharing the town's white pickup, learning materials, work tasks, a possible laptop, and providing maps.
- There was a discussion on an unexpected but necessary repair to a fire truck. SO moved and TB seconded a motion to pay the invoice. Motion passed. Deb Ahlstrom will be consulted on funding sources.
- SO moved and TB seconded a motion to sign the State Bridge Aid Project Agreement for Madbury 41462, Freshet Rd. Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS

- There was a discussion of the proposed extension of a recreation trail. After some concerns about the cost and *lack of* public input, EF was asked to schedule the Recreation Commission Chair, Gordon Davenport and member Justin Corrow for a visit with the Select Board.
- There was a review of the submitted requested changes to the MRI fire study. It was noted that the summary of options provided was not the requested executive summary. The Board discussed the need to clarify to the public that \(\pi\)the study options and recommendations are not necessarily Chief Perley's recommendations nor the town's final decision. TB will work on language to go along with the posting of the study to the town website ahead of a public presentation being scheduled for May 23, 2024.

BOARD UPDATES

• MA reported that the Planning Board was working on their housing implementation table and they will address the issue of a letter ending a conditional use permit at their next meeting.

OTHER:

• Portsmouth will attend the Select Board meeting on May 17, 2024.
