

Town of Madbury
Winter Weather Road Maintenance Ordinance

Authority

This ordinance is enacted under the authority granted by RSA 41:11 as described in RSA 47:17¹.

Purpose:

This ordinance provides for the safe, efficient and orderly maintenance of public highways, sidewalks and commons. The provisions of this ordinance facilitate essential snow removal operations and prevent unsafe driving and walking conditions.

Requirements:


Parking is prohibited on all streets and roads during snow removal, salting and sanding operations. Drivers must anticipate such operations whenever weather creates the need. Operations may continue well after any initial treatment. Vehicles parked in the right of way (typically 25 feet from the centerline of the road) during such operations shall be deemed in violation of this ordinance and shall be towed at the owner's risk and expense.


It shall be a violation to plow, shovel, blow, throw or otherwise deposit snow on a public way including Class V and Class VI roads and sidewalks.

Any person who violates this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and subject to a \$100 fine. Each repeated violation instance shall be subject to this fine.

This ordinance superseded the Snow Removal Parking Ordinance of November 2, 1987 and become effective on April 20, 2015. Amended August 1, 2016
