

## The Madbury 250th Anniversary Commemorative License Plate

In 1768 the Madbury Parish was granted town privileges by Governor John Wentworth. A time of celebration and remembrance will be marked in 2018 as the Town celebrates its 250th Anniversary. A planning committee has worked with the Selectmen and received approval from the NH-DMV for a commemorative front license plate to be made available for sale. The Town Clerk will start selling them on Wednesday, November 15, during regular business hours. She will take cash or check made out to the Town of Madbury. The cost is \$20 each. Proceeds go to fund other anniversary events and to the Town's general fund.



### The Rules for Display

- One commemorative plate may be attached to the front of a motor vehicle in place of the regular number plate; however, the rear number plate must remain in place. (RSA 261:91-a)
- A vehicle displaying a commemorative plate must be legally registered and inspected for the current year.
- Vehicles registered anywhere in NH may display this plate. Owners of vehicles registered in other states should check with that state before displaying it on an out-of-state registered vehicle.
- These plates may be displayed from January 1, 2018, until December 31, 2018. Remember where you store your current front plate for when it needs to go back on your vehicle at the end of the year.
- Law enforcement and inspection stations will be notified in December 2017 of what towns have approved commemorative plates for 2018.
