



## Madbury Town Office Closures

(Sunday, March 29, 2020)

The COVID-19 outbreak is evolving rapidly, and federal and state recommendations would have us adjust how we provide services to reduce exposure to both our residents and town employees.

**Effective Wednesday, March 18, 2020 and until further notice, the Madbury Town Offices will be closed to the public.** However, we will do our best to continue to provide all necessary services, some on a case by case basis. As appropriate, town employees will maintain their regular office hours, but limit contact with the public through the closure. For specific office information, please see below. **We will provide updates via the Madbury Post, the town website, and kiosk at town hall.**

This is a fee-based service and the exact fee (as low as \$0.95) will be shown prior to completing your online transaction.
