(Tuesday, March 31, 2020)

The COVID-19 outbreak is evolving rapidly, and federal and state recommendations would have us adjust how we provide services to reduce exposure to both our residents and town employees.

Effective Wednesday, March 18, 2020 and until further notice, the Madbury Town Offices will be closed to the public. However, we will do our best to continue to provide all necessary services, some on a case by case basis. As appropriate, town employees will maintain their regular office hours, but limit contact with the public through the closure.
